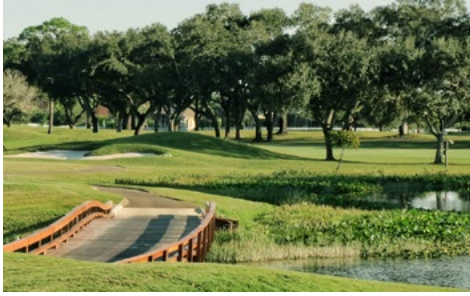

Grande Oaks Golf Club

1:30 p.m. shotgun start with lunch on the carts

Best known for being the golf course used for the filming of the hit film Caddyshack, starring Bill Murray and Rodney Dangerfield, Grande Oaks Golf Club is an 18-hole course just a few miles east of Downtown Fort Lauderdale. Be tournament ready as prizes will be awarded for closest to the pin, longest drive and the winning foursome. Golfers will board a shuttle for a 30-minute transfer to the course for a 1:00 p.m. shotgun start. Lunch will be provided on the carts and a beverage cart available throughout the event.

Attire: No denim or cargo shorts. Men are REQUIRED to wear a shirt with a collar. All shirts MUST be tucked in; ladies tailored waist length golf shirts need not be tucked in. Ladies' and men's shorts are to be appropriate length. Soft spikes only.

Transfer Time: 30 minutes – Buses will depart the hotel at 12:45 p.m.

Transfer Time: 40 minutes – Buses will depart the hotel at 1:30 p.m.



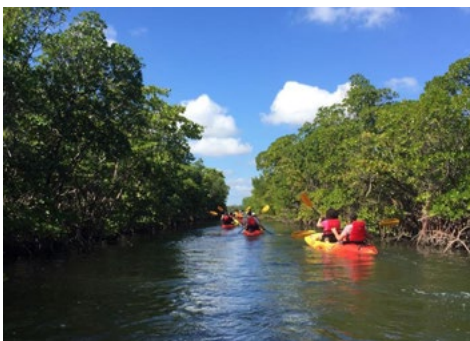

Kayak The Mangroves ALFA International Wellness Worldwide

Begin this journey kayaking in the largest tract of mangrove forest in Southeastern Florida. Beach your kayak at the Anne Kolb Nature Center and visit the mangrove forest exhibit as well as an aquarium that features fish species of estuarine habitats. Take a guided walk along a winding boardwalk nestled in this unique ecosystem. You can also head to the top of a 68-foot structure for spectacular views of the mangrove estuary, West Lake, the Intracoastal waterway and the Atlantic Ocean.
