CHRISTA MARKWALDER has been a member of the Foreign Affairs Committee since 2003, which she chaired in 2010-2011, and a member of the Legal Affairs Committee. From 2007-2011, she was a member of the Swiss delegation to the Interparliamentary Union. She chairs the parliamentary Switzerland-USA and Switzerland-UK friendship groups and is co-president of the Switzerland-Ukraine friendship group. She is also on the parliamentary group for renewable energies, Green Cross, ski group of the Federal Assembly, a member of the executive committee of the FDP, and part of The Liberals Women Switzerland and the party leadership of the Liberal Party of the Canton of Bern. In 2015-2016, she chaired the National Council and the United Federal Assembly, making her the highest-ranking woman in Switzerland. Christa is one of the Young Leaders of the American Swiss Foundation (YL 2006) and the Young Global Leaders of the World Economic Forum (YGL 2011). Since January 2008, she has served as legal counsel with Zurich Financial Services.
