## ROCK CLIMBING

3:00PM – 5:30PM

Challenge yourself with a tremendous climb in the beautiful setting of the Mount Mansfield Region of Stowe, Vermont, scaling cliffs and taking in all the boreal forest has to offer. This outing is perfect for anyone who wants to try out climbing for the first time. Shorter, “top roped” climbs will be offered, which are great for every ability level. This is an excellent opportunity for those who are new to the sport.

### SUGGESTED ATTIRE:

Comfortable clothing and shoes. Climbing equipment and bottled water will be provided.

**TRANSFER TIME:** Attendees will walk from the hotel about 25 minutes to the location of the climbing pitch.



## ZIP LINE

2:00PM – 5:00PM

Step up, clip in, and you're flying! Following a mountain brook from high above Smugglers' Notch Resort Village, you'll soar down 8 zip lines, cross 2 suspension bridges, and rappel from trees. Along the way, learn about the local ecology and natural history, and take in spectacular views of the Green Mountains. This is not an amusement ride. It is a participatory adventure sport. Participants are responsible for controlling their speed as they descend the zip line. Participants will attend a ground school prior to heading out on the course.

### SUGGESTED ATTIRE:

Comfortable clothing including a windproof jacket, close-toed shoes. Bottled water will be provided.

## E-BIKE TOUR

Cruise the Stowe Recreation Path and take in the beauty of Vermont in comfort as you ride on a pedal assisted e-bike. During this guided trip bikers will enjoy the mostly flat 5.5 mile recreation path, touring the town of Stowe, cruising along the West Branch River and crossing the many bridges that make biking in this area unique. Stop at Alchemist Brewing for a refreshment before heading back up the path. The bikes are pedal assisted, and although you will pedal your bike, the electronic assist allows for a comfortable and leisurely ride.

### HORSEBACK RIDING

Upon exiting the grove of Blue Spruce and Pine trees, the mountain views will take your breath away. Mount Mansfield and Smugglers' Notch stand proud and majestic above the tree line. As you ride through the open fields, you may see some white tail deer or a family of fox, as well as a variety of birds and turkeys. Whether you are a beginner or an experienced rider, everyone is sure to enjoy!
