#### Advantages of Early Resolution

- 1. Individual settlements are less expensive than litigation costs;
- 2. Avoidance of legal representation for a claimant;
- 3. Avoidance of pre-litigation issues (preservation requests; vehicle inspections; etc.);
- 4. Avoidance of litigation including potential negligence claims against the company, spoliation of evidence; corporate depositions, expert retention, discovery and related expenses, etc.;
- 5. Avoidance of claim building;
- 6. Avoidance of nuclear verdicts; and
- 7. A quick and final resolution of claims.

### Disadvantages of Early Resolution

- 1. Knowledge/perception in the community that your company will pay claims (even disputed claims);
- 2. Invites the claimant to retain counsel after receiving a settlement offer from the company;
- 3. Inability to perform legal discovery (investigation of the claimant's background, accident history, claims history, medical history, etc.);
- 4. Overpaying claims;
- 5. Resolution of some claims, but not all claims;
- 6. Dissatisfaction between the company and driver regarding resolution of a defensible claim;
- 7. Jeopardizes negotiations with claimants and attorneys if early resolution is not achieved; and
- 8. Is it economically beneficial to pay smaller amounts for numerous claims or to pay larger amounts for lesser claims and defend claims that are defensible.
