All Aboard Pikes Peak Cog Railway!

Experience America's peak from a whole new perspective! Hop aboard the Pikes Peak Cog Railway for the 1-hour 10-minute journey to the summit of Pikes Peak. At the top, spend 40 minutes taking in the beautiful views and enjoying a delicious world-famous donut from High Altitude Donuts before heading back down the mountain to Manitou Springs.

Note: Boxed lunches will be available for all attendees on the bus.

Attire: Casual clothing and layers recommended. The temperature at Pikes Peak is typically 30 degrees colder than the base, so please dress accordingly. Don't forget your cameras!
