EL YUNQUE NATIONAL RAINFOREST TOUR

1:30 - 5:30 PM

Today's visit will take attendees to the only Tropical Rainforest in the US Forest System. This magnificent forest spans 29,000 acres and has a highest peak of over 3,500 ft. over sea level, known as El Yunque, which was formerly known as the Caribbean National Forest. This tour of the forest will take attendees to three different stops. The first stop will be at the top of Yokahu Tower to enjoy a 360-degree view of the Forest. The second stop will be at La Coca Falls, a magnificent backdrop for photos. The final stop will be an interpretive trip down Angelito Trail, where a guide will share interesting facts about the abundant flora and fauna in the Forest.

SUGGESTED ATTIRE:

Light and comfortable clothes, comfortable closed-toe walking/hiking shoes, sunglasses and sunscreen or hat.

RAINFOREST ZIPLINE ADVENTURE

Your adventure begins with a guided nature walk along easy rainforest trails, where expert guides share insights into El Yunque's rich history, flora, and wildlife, along with views of its beautiful natural pools. The experience continues with an exhilarating zipline adventure featuring nine state-of-the-art lines soaring above the treetops.

SUGGESTED ATTIRE:

Comfortable clothing, closed toe – good traction shoes are REQUIRED, sunglasses and sunscreen or hat.

Set sail on a catamaran to the uninhabited paradise of Icacos Island, cruising turquoise Caribbean waters with scenic views of El Yunque and Puerto Rico's eastern coastline. Upon arrival, enjoy white-sand beaches and crystal-clear waters—perfect for swimming, snorkeling, or relaxing in the sun. The crew offers easy, hands-on snorkeling instruction for beginners. Towels, snacks and refreshments will be provided.

CACAO FARM EXPERIENCE
